## EN COVID-19 Precautionary Measures

### **Welcome to the Musée de Charmey!**

The Musée de Charmey welcomes you from Tuesday to Sunday, from 2pm to 6pm.

We kindly ask that visitors comply with the museum's hygiene and distancing rules at all times.

### **Hand hygiene:**

- Hand sanitiser dispensers are available at the museum entrance. All visitors must disinfect their hands upon arrival.

### **Cleaning:**

- All surfaces – reception and shop furniture, mediation materials, handrails, door handles and WCs – are cleaned and disinfected on a regular basis.

### **Safe distancing:**

- The maximum number of visitors in the reception and shop area is limited to 2 persons (except for persons sharing a household).

### **Visiting the exhibition:**

- Wearing a mask is mandatory in the reception area and in the store.
- Presentation of the COVID certificate is mandatory from the age of 16. To be presented with an ID.
- With the introduction of the certificate requirement, masks are not required in the exhibition areas.
- The sales lists, available at the entrance of the Museum of Charmey, are for one-time use only. At the end of the visit, they are to be taken away or disposed of in the basket provided for this purpose.
- When you pass someone in the corridors and stairways, the person leaving (and therefore going down) has priority. Please keep your distance in these smaller spaces.
- Until October 24, 2021: third country nationals can present their vaccination certificate.
- Our reception staff is available to answer any questions you may have.

### **Guided tours and cultural mediation services:**

- Presentation of the COVID certificate is mandatory from the age of 16. To be presented with an ID.
- School groups during opening hours: for students aged 16 and over, teachers and accompanying persons, presentation of a certificate is mandatory. Students under 16 years of age are not required to present a COVID certificate or wear a mask.
- School groups during closing hours: the mandatory certificate does not apply.

### **Processing of personal data:**

- When verifying the certificate, the application does not save any data in a central system or in the application.
